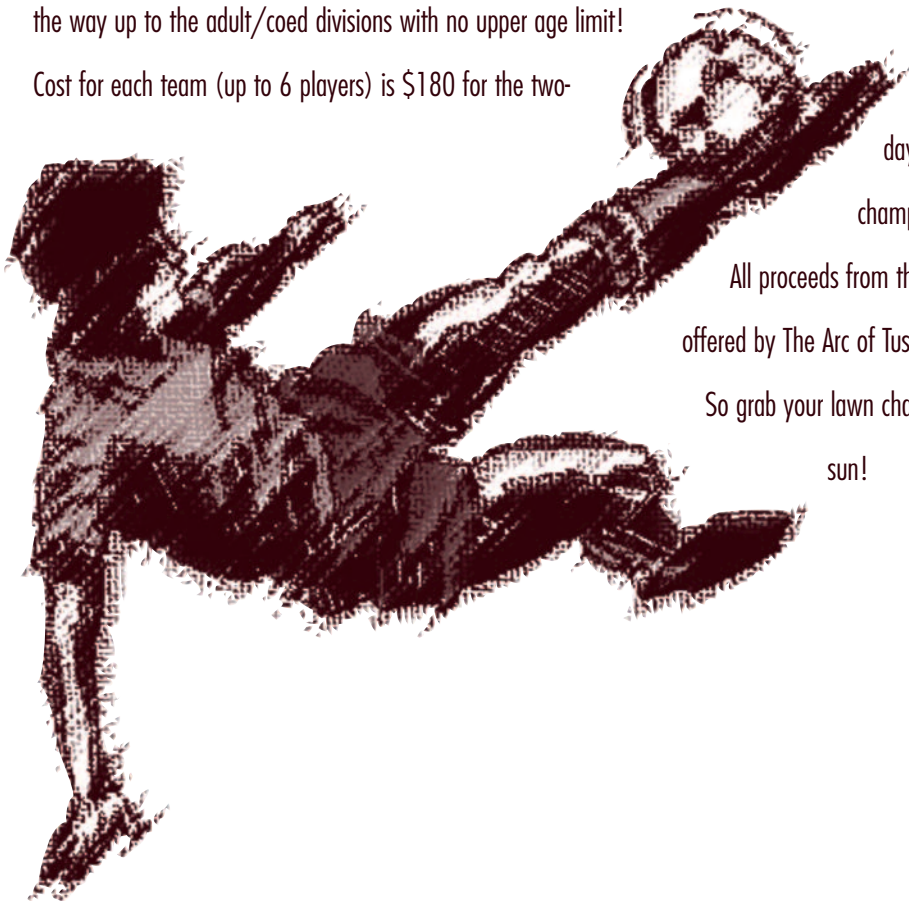
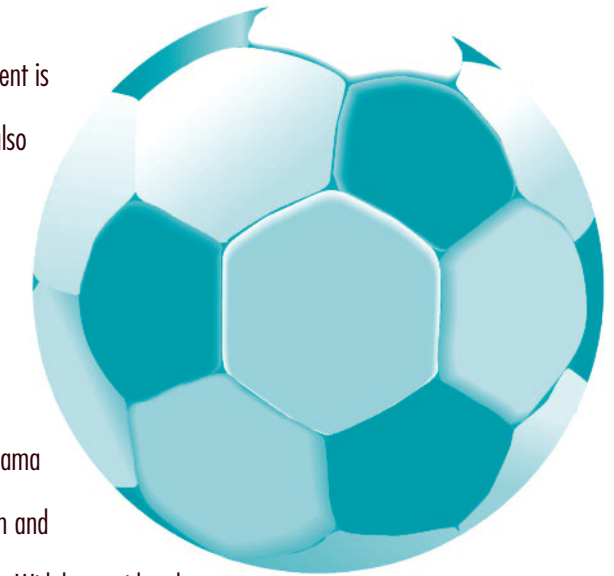
# Crimson Cup Soccer

Soccer is coming to Tuscaloosa in a big way! The Crimson Cup Soccer Tournament is scheduled for August 28-29, 2010 at Sokol Park North, 6655 Old Watermelon Road (also site of the Model Airfield). The tournament will be a 3v3 format (3 on 3) and the top three winners in each age range will qualify to compete in the World Cup 3v3 Soccer Championship in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina in August of 2011.

Coach Todd Bramble, head coach of The Alabama Crimson Tide Women's Soccer team, is serving as honorary chairman of the event. This is the *only* tournament in Alabama that is a qualifier for the World Cup 3v3. The tournament will provide a high quality, fun and family oriented event for all participants, teams, spectators, sponsors, partners and fans. Widely considered the most popular sport in the world, soccer has gained popularity in the United States in the past two decades.

The tournament offers something for everyone starting with the youth divisions for kids in the U8 division ("under" eight years of age) and going all the way up to the adult/coed divisions with no upper age limit!

Cost for each team (up to 6 players) is \$180 for the two-



day event. Each team is guaranteed 4 games and the championship playoff games will be held on Sunday afternoon.

All proceeds from the tournament will go to support the programs and services offered by The Arc of Tuscaloosa County.
